


Geographic Distribution (largest concentration of alumni by state*)

ANNUAL GIVING

State Support: Approximately 56.7% of UMBC's budget comes from tuition and state appropriations. The rest is covered by grants, contracts, charitable contributions, and auxiliary support.

Financial Aid: More than 66% of full-time undergraduates applied for need-based financial aid in Fall 2015. Of those, 48% received financial aid in some form.
